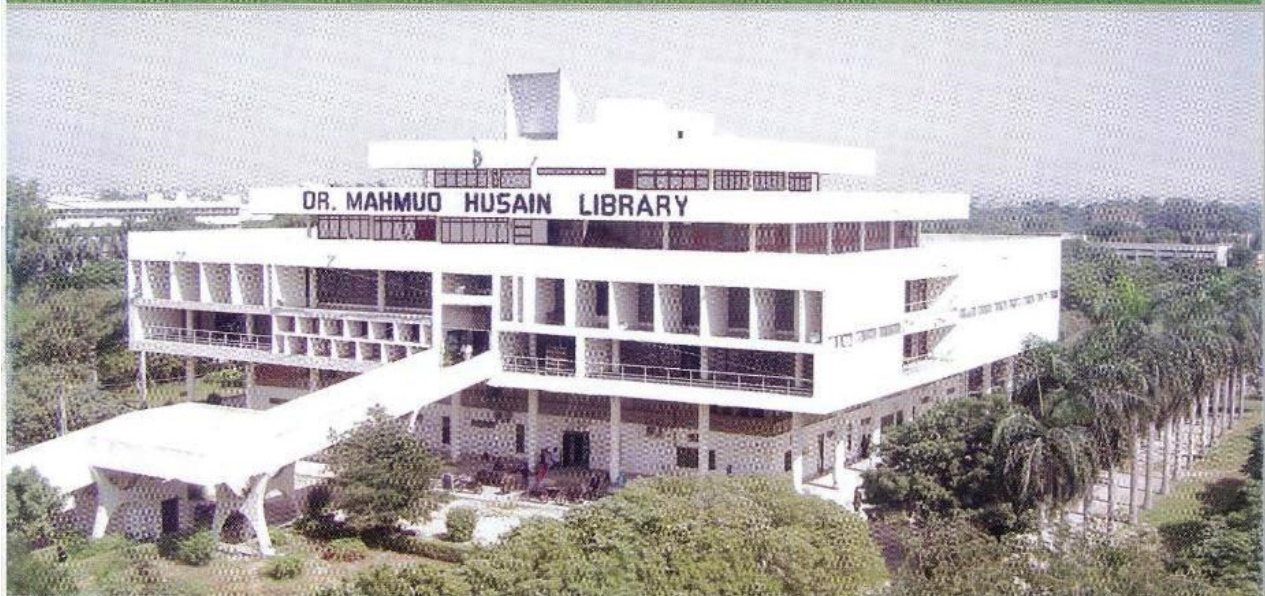

Historical Back Ground of University of Karachi

The University of Karachi was established under the University of Karachi Act in June 1951. It was initially housed in few buildings in a congested locality of Karachi. The University was shifted to its present campus that encompasses around 1279 acres in 1960. University of Karachi is one of the biggest Universities of Pakistan in terms of areas and Faculty size.

There are 8 faculties, 54 Departments and 21 Research Institutes/Centres. The University offers academic programs in B.S., Pharm-D (Pharmacy), BBA, BPA, B.E, B.L.I.S, M.S., M.A., M.Sc., M.L.I.S., M.P.A., M. Com., MBA, M. Pharm., Ph.D., D. Sc., D. Litt. Besides Certificates and Diploma courses are also offered in French, German, Arabic, Turkish, Persian, Bengali Languages and also in Petroleum Technology, Environmental Science, Statistics, Public Administration. These above programs are offered in the following departments and Research Institutes of the University.

The department and Institutes/Centres are imparting education to more than 33000 students including students from foreign countries.

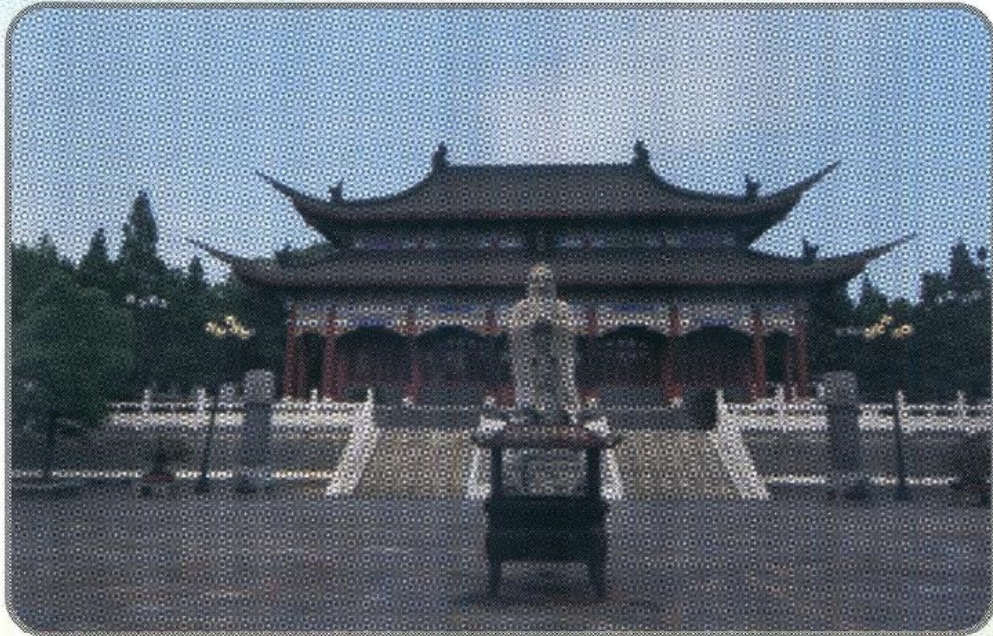
The faculty comprises

ABOUT HANBAN AND SICHUAN NORMAL UNIVERSITY, CHINA



As China's economy and exchanges with the world have seen rapid growth, there has also been a sharp increase in the world's demands for Chinese learning. Benefiting from the UK, France, Germany and Spain's experience in promoting their national languages, China began its own exploration through establishing non-profit public institutions which aim to promote Chinese language and culture in foreign countries in 2004: these were given the name the Confucius Institute.

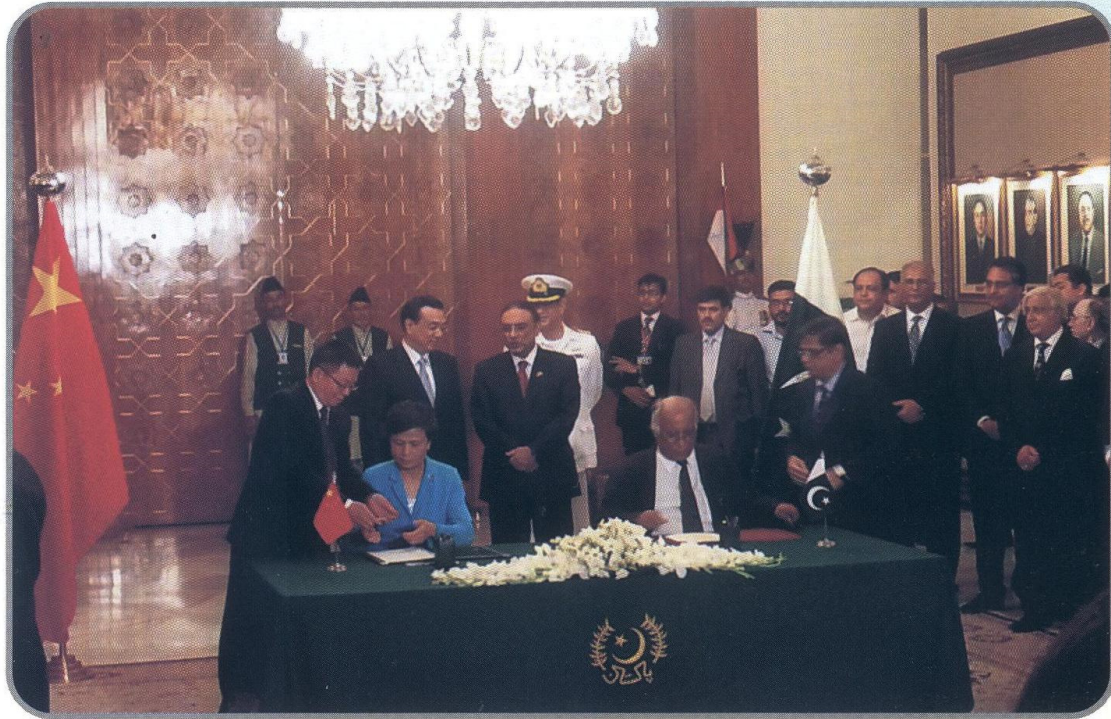
This university offers scholarships in all fields of education and especially in Chinese language and culture.

With the impressive work of NUML in Islamabad, Chinese Government and Hanban Headquarters allow Sichuan Normal University to start work on opening of another institute at University of Karachi.

The President of Sichuan Normal University requested through Chinese Government to Government of Pakistan for the establishment of Confucius Institute at University of Karachi.

The collaboration between Sichuan Normal University and University of Karachi was started in 2012. The MOU and agreement were signed in 23 May 2013 in President House in the presence of former President of Pakistan, Mr. Asif ali Zardari and Prime Ministry of China Mr. Li Keqiang.
