## Admissions-2020

**For information to those candidates who are going to be appeared in Entry Test held on 17-11-2019.**

**Those candidates who have passed the Intermediate with Pre-Engineering OR Pre-Medical will be appeared in the entry test of Group -1.**

A total of 6 (Six) subjects will be included in Question Paper for Group No.1. In which 4 (Four) subjects i.e. English, General Knowledge, Chemistry and Physics will be compulsory, whereas 5<sup>th</sup> (Fifth) subject will be optional. The Intermediate Pre-Medical group will opt. **BIOLOGY**, as well as Pre-Engineering group, opt **MATHEMATICS**. Twenty (20) questions will be in every subject. It will be compulsory to answer 100 (Hundred) questions.

**Those candidates who have passed the Intermediate with General Science will be appeared in the entry test of Group-2.**

A total of 7 (Seven) subjects will be included in Question Paper for Group No.2. In which 2 (Two) subjects i.e. English and General Knowledge will be compulsory, whereas 3 (Three) optional subjects opt by General Science candidate from the 5 (five) optional subjects, which were he/she studied in Intermediate General Science Group. Twenty (20) questions will be in every subject. It will be compulsory to answer 100 (Hundred) questions.

**Those candidates who have passed the Diploma of Associate Engineer (DAE) will be appeared in the entry test of Group -3.**

A total of 3 (Three) subjects will be included in Question Paper for Group No.3. In which English, General Knowledge and 3<sup>rd</sup> subject will be included from the Diploma of Associate Engineering subjects. The marks of test papers will be consist of English 20 (Twenty), General Knowledge 20 (Twenty) and 60 (Sixty) from the DAE subjects. The Test Paper is consists of 100 (Hundred) questions and all the questions are compulsory.

**Those candidates who have passed the Intermediate with Home Economics will be appeared in the entry test of Group -4.**

A total of 3 (three) parts will be in Question Paper for Group No.4. In which English, General Knowledge and third part from Home Economics subjects will be included. The marks of test papers will be consist of English 20 (Twenty), General Knowledge 20 (Twenty) and third part in 60 (sixty) number from Home Economics Subjects. The Test Paper is consists of 100 (Hundred) questions and all the questions are compulsory.

**Those candidates who have passed the Intermediate with Humanities will be appeared in the entry test of Group-5.**

A total of 24 (Twenty Four) subjects will be included in Question Paper for Group No.5. In which 2 (Two) subjects will be compulsory. English and General Knowledge included as compulsory subjects, whereas a total of 22 (Twenty Two) subjects will be as optional subjects. The Intermediate Humanities Group will be opted three subjects which he/she were studied in Intermediate. Twenty (20) questions will be in every subject. It will be compulsory to answer 100 (Hundred) questions.

**Those candidates who have passed the Intermediate with Commerce OR Diploma of Business Administration OR Diploma in Commerce will be appeared in the entry test of Group-6.**

A total of 3 (Three) subjects will be included in Question Paper for Group No.6. In which English, General Knowledge and third subject consist of Intermediate Commerce/Diploma of Business Administration/ Diploma in Commerce subjects. The marks of test papers will be consist of English 20 (Twenty), General Knowledge 20 (Twenty) and third subject in 60 (sixty) number. The Test Paper is consists of 100 (Hundred) questions and all the questions are compulsory.

Group number of the candidate, Examination Centre and Room No. is already mentioned in the Admit Card. The candidates are directed to must report at the Examination Centre / Room at 10:30 a.m. sharp. Admit Cards can be downloaded from portal.
