Acceptance Requirements and Criteria

To be eligible for admission into the 5 years Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) program at the University of Karachi, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Academic Qualifications: Completion of Higher Secondary Certificate (H.S.C.) in the Pre-Medical group or an equivalent international qualification, with a minimum of 60% marks (Grade 'B'). Admissions are test-based, with a minimum of 50 % passing marks.
- Merit-Based Admission: Admission is competitive, with 200 seats allocated on a merit basis for the morning Pharm.D. program and 100 seats in the evening Pharm. D program, including reserved seats for international students.
- **Degree Upgradation:** Individuals holding three- or four-year pharmacy degrees can upgrade to the five-year Pharm.D. program by completing the necessary deficiency courses.
