Split 2+2 BS Program in Chinese

Introduction

Confucius Institute at University of Karachi (CIUK) was jointly established by University of Karachi and Sichuan Normal University in China in 2013. CIUK is a non-profit education institution with the aim of communicating Chinese, deepening international understanding of Chinese language and culture, and promoting people-to-people exchanges between China and Pakistan. Since its inception, CIUK has developed from a small institute into the largest Chinese language center in Pakistan in terms of the number of teachers, students and teaching sites.

The split 2+2 BS program in Chinese is hosted by Sichuan Normal University and University of Karachi. Program students shall study two years in University of Karachi to complete the required courses and qualified students will be granted scholarship to study in Sichuan Normal University in the remaining two years. Students who meet the graduation requirements shall be awarded joint BS degree by both universities.

Facilities

CIUK has two computer language labs, a library with a stock of 8000 books, air-conditioned classrooms with modern teaching facilities, conference room, Auditorium and activity room for multiple purposes.

Admission Requirement for BS Chinese Program

Number of Seats: 20

Fee Structure: In accordance with the University of Karachi regulations in the first two academic years, qualified students will obtain full scholarship for the 3rd and 4th academic years in Sichuan Normal University in China.

Eligibility Criteria: Intermediate or equivalent with at least 45% marks, under 24 years old at the time of application.

Admission Test: English Test.

Interview: Top 40 applicants in the merit (Intermediate marks and Aptitude Test marks) will appear in Departmental Interview.

Merit Formula:

Academic Qualification 50%+ English Test 40%+Interview 10%=Aggregate Score 100
