Authors are invited to submit their Short length paper via e-mail to Intconf.2025@gmail.com after labeling their document file as: Author-Theme (i.e. Noman-Forestry and environment.doc). It should consists of minimum 1500 words containing sections of title, authors, affiliations, abstract, keywords, introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, and references. A minimum of 3 Figures/Tables and a minimum of 10 references should be present in it. All the text should be in Times New Roman, 12pt, justified alignment and single spacing throughout body text while headings in bold with 6pt spacing before paragraph. These short communications according to selected format will be published in Scopus indexed Springer book series (possibly in SPEES https://www.springer.com/series/16067).
